

AHA BLS, ACLS, and PALS Recertification Opportunity

American Heart Association (AHA) BLS, ACLS, and PALS recertification opportunity for required nursing staff is available at UCSF Health via Nursing Connect.

How does it work?

- Log into <u>Nursing Connect</u>, search for: "CPR" or "Heartcode", and enroll in either BLS, ACLS, or PALS (Direct link: https://tinyurl.com/UCSFCPR)
- Complete the self-paced e-Learning
 - BLS (around 2 hours)
 - ACLS (around 6 hours)
 - PALS (around 6 hours)
- Upon completion of the in-person skills returned demonstration at a UCSF Health location is REQUIRED to complete your certification
